Class	Wrinkling	Score	Description		
ı	- Fine wrinkles	1 -3	Mild: Fine texture changes with subtly accentuated skin lines.		
11	- Fine to moderate depth wrinkles - Moderate number of lines	4-6	Moderate: Distinct popular elastosis (individual papules with yellow translucency under direct lighting) and dyschromia		
III	- Fine to deep wrinkles, numerous lines - With or without redundant skin folds	7 -9	Severe: Multipapular and confluent elastosis (thickened, yellow and pallid) approaching or consistent with cutis rhomboidalis
